Do you like walking tours? Try the downtown area looking at many buildings with the original façade, or the Heritage Center, Courthouse, Robert Emmet Statute and Blarney Stone, The Doll House, Mural Park.

Or Drive east from downtown - Stop at the Historical Museum and the Victorian House

Or Drive south from downtown - Pass the new Veterans Memorial, see the one-room schoolhouse at the Palo Alto Fair grounds in the south part of Emmetsburg.

Or Drive West from downtown - See the Little House on the Prairie

Or Drive North from downtown along Lawler Street - Visit Kearny State Park and the Dragoon Monument, both next to the golf course.

Be sure to stop at McNally’s Bakery for coffee and delicious baked goods.
